Park runs parallel to Ballyquin Road (B68) and Drumrane Road (B192). Signed from both roads.


ROUTE DESCRIPTION

Roe Valley Country Park offers a variety of routes along the riverside and through woodland. Combining legend with industrial and natural heritage, the park has great appeal.

A variety of paths exist throughout this linear park which runs for approx. 3.5 miles either side of the River Roe. See park leaflet and on site interpretation.

There is also a Sensory Trail designed for the visually impaired.
